As an institution accredited by the Council on Occupational Education (COE) Abcott Institute hereby certifies that the completion, placement, and licensure (where applicable) information provided below was submitted to COE in March 2023 as part of its annual report and is the most recent data available. All information provided is for students graduating or completing program requirements between the reporting period of July 1, 2021- June 30, 2022. Abcott Institute uses COE's completion, placement, and licensure definitions and formulas to calculate rates.

Completion rates are the percentage of students who have demonstrated the competencies required for a program and have been awarded the appropriate credential (graduate completer) or have acquired sufficient competencies through a program to become employed in the field of education pursued or a related field as evidenced by such employment (non-graduate completer) within reporting period.

Placement rates are the percentage of completers of a program who (1) are employed in the field of education pursued or in a related field, or (2) have received the appropriate credential and entered the military or continued his/her education within reporting period. Valid employment in the field or a related field includes placement in a permanent full- or part-time position with an employer or employment agency, or self-employment in the field of education or a related field. Internships and externships, either paid or unpaid, do not qualify as placement.

Licensure Rates are the percentage of students that have successfully attempted and passed a required test (either by the state or federally) prior to obtaining employment after graduation from some programs.
